## System Requirements:

NOTE: SOSx Lite will run on systems with specs below these, but the software may exhibit some unexpected behavior such as slow performance.

- Minimum resolution: 1280x720
- 64 bit operating system including Windows 7 or newer, OS X 10.8 or newer
- I3 (I5, I7) or newer CPU
- 8 GB of RAM
- 2 GB of video RAM (preferably a discrete graphics card)
- 15 GB of free hard drive space
- May require administrative rights to your computer to install
